After 8:00 AM, **exterior doors are locked**. Only the main "A" doors are equipped with a doorbell to request entry through the office.

If your child arrives after 8:00 AM, an adult must accompany them into the building and sign them in at the office. This process confirms that your child has safely arrived and parental care has been transferred to the school for the day.
