Bagels will be available for pick up at IVS (date tbd). Money raised goes towards the Robert MacMurray Bursary Fund and IVS Fun Day.

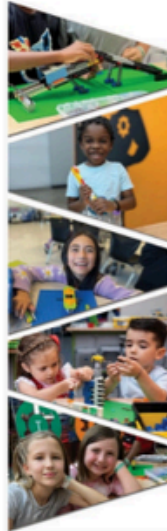
